Summary of Weekly Missionary Program at CrossRoads

Purpose

Adults, couples, or families will serve as missionaries to the summer campers and staff at CrossRoads Camp & Conference Center. Campers will learn about the missionary's ministries and personal faith journey through presentations and informal interaction. The missionary will build relationships with summer staff to encourage them and help broaden their view of the world and missions.

Responsibilities

1. Prepare and present a presentation about the people group or country with which you work and the ministries with which you are involved. Provide interactive or hands-on learning activities for the campers during the presentation. The program will be implemented three to four days of the camp week and should last about 45 minutes.
2. Be available throughout the week during activities to answer questions, speak with campers about your experiences, and participate in activities so that the campers will have opportunities to get to know you.
3. Assist with counseling individual campers as needed.
4. Participate in camp worship at least once during the week by sharing a missions story or testimony.
5. Be available to lead at least one evening devotion for program staff or campers.
6. Volunteer in other camp programs and activities such as the camp store, talent show, recreation, etc. as needed.

Qualifications

1. Participant(s) must meet at least one of the following qualifications:
 - Be currently serving in a stateside ministry
 - Be currently on furlough in Virginia from an international ministry assignment
 - Be retired from a full-time missions position
 - Have completed a volunteer missions trip within the past year
2. Experience working with children is preferred.
3. Adult participants must agree to a background check.

Benefits Provided

1. Transportation reimbursement for travel done within Virginia.

4. One child per missionary who is old enough to be a camper may attend camp for 50% off on the same week that his/her parents are serving. Younger children may participate in some camp activities but will need to be supervised by parents.
5. Summer Camp t-shirts provided for each family member attending.

Application Process

1. Contact Nicole Todd at 434.277.8465 or ntodd@crossroadscsc.org to select a week to serve at camp. Weeks will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
2. Fill out the Volunteer Packet and mail the completed packet to CrossRoads.
3. In addition to the volunteer packet please provide a one to two paragraph bio and photograph that we may post on our summer camp website.
4. You will receive a packing list and other details about your week of service in May.

Frequently Asked Questions

- **When does the camp week begin and end?**
 - You should arrive at Check-In sometime between 3:00pm and 5:00pm on Monday. Camp weeks end at 11:30am on Saturday after the closing program.
- **Where will I stay?**
 - Missionaries are lodged in the House of Happiness with other weekly volunteers. This building is set up suite style with two rooms sharing one bathroom. Single missionaries may be given roommates; families or couples will be housed together in a room. Linens are provided.
- **Do you have equipment that I may use?**
 - CrossRoads can provide a projector to hook to your laptop, CD player, overhead projector, whiteboards, etc. Please provide plenty of notice if you would like to use any of these items.
- **How many campers will be in each presentation session?**
 - During most weeks, there will be no more than 30 campers in your presentation at one time. You will always have counselors, staff, or volunteers in the presentation to assist you in any way that they can. We will be able to provide more exact numbers and schedules closer to the time of your arrival.
- **What ages are the campers?**
 - Except for Family Camp, all campers have completed grades 4-11 (generally 10 – 17 years of age).
